

Add a little magic to your school with Disney Musicals in Schools, an initiative of Virginia Repertory Theatre that ignites a passion for storytelling by building sustainable musical theatre programs in Chesterfield County public elementary schools.

By providing free performance materials and free professional development to participating schools, Disney Musicals in Schools has helped schools across the US and UK launch new theater programs, inspiring the next generation of diverse storytellers, artists, and audiences.

Up to five schools will be selected to participate in the 2023-2024 year program **free of charge**. Any Chesterfield County public elementary school with a Title 1 designation are eligible to apply, but hurry—the application deadline is **September 25th, 2023**.

The goals of Disney Musicals in Schools are to:

- 1. Create sustainable musical theatre programs in public elementary schools.
- 2. Provide school faculty with the training and tools necessary to support student performance and production, and to empower them to do so.
- 3. Develop a critical awareness and appreciation of the arts within the school.
- 4. Develop a strong community, including students, parents, faculty, staff, and neighbors.
- 5. Expose students and school faculty to the wide spectrum of skills that are developed when producing a piece of musical theatre, including critical thinking, problem solving, ensemble building, communication, self-confidence, and interpersonal skills.

Disney Musicals in Schools presents a special opportunity to introduce the collaborative art of musical theatre to your school, strengthen your arts programming, and develop partnerships among students, faculty, staff, and the greater community.

Please note: Recipient schools will receive various levels of support over a period of three years. Since the goal of the program is to build sustainable theater programs, applications from schools that have participated in the program in the last five years will not be considered.

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Selected schools will receive:

- Free performance license to a 30-minute Disney KIDS musical (available shows include 101 Dalmatians, Aladdin, The Artistocats, Finding Nemo, Frozen, The Jungle Book, The Lion King, and Winnie the Pooh)
- **Free** ShowKit materials, including a director's guide, student scripts, accompaniment and rehearsal tracks, choreography videos, and cross-curricular activities.
- **Free** weekly 90-minute in-school visits from a team of two Virginia Repertory Theatre Teaching Artists to train and guide your team throughout the process.
- \$350 production budget support from Virginia Repertory Theatre.
- Two 8x4 flats to be kept by the school and used for future productions.
- Lastly, the selected schools will participate in a culminating Disney Musicals in Schools Student Share Celebration. At this event, each school will share selections from its production at Virginia Rep Center for Arts and Education's Jessie Bogese Theatre.

Selected schools will be expected to:

- Produce a 30-minute Disney KIDS musical involving 3rd-5th graders both on and off stage.
- Identify a School Team comprising at least three teachers and staff members, who will
 partner with the Virginia Repertory Theatre Teaching Artists and oversee and manage
 the program from beginning to end. The selected School Team will receive on-site
 support from a team of two Virginia Repertory Theatre Teaching Artists who will visit
 the school each week. The School Team will also run a 90-minute rehearsal on their own
 once each week.
- Commit to a full semester of rehearsal /production in an after-school setting.
- Host a site visit for the selection team during the application process.
- Provide space, time, materials, and resources for students and the School Team to rehearse and prepare for the musical production.
- Provide opportunities for the whole school, parents, and larger community to be connected to the production.
- Hold a minimum of one public performance of the musical.
- Participate in the culminating Student Share event at Virginia Rep Center for Arts and Education's Jessie Bogese Theatre, and provide transportation for participating students. Costs to be reimbursed by Virginia Repertory Theatre.

Financial Commitment

Performance rights, ShowKit materials, Professional Development, and onsite Teaching Artist support will be provided at no charge to selected schools. Selected schools will be responsible for a production budget outside of the \$350 provided by Virginia Repertory Theatre. Disney KIDS Musicals are designed to be produced inexpensively, and have been successfully mounted within a budget of \$300-\$1500. Virginia Repertory Theatre Teaching Artists will work to maximize the school's production budget by using reclaimed and existing materials, such as cardboard boxes and t-shirts brought from home. Virginia Repertory Theatre will provide a stipend of \$1,200 for three teachers from each of the four schools.
