Richmond, VA -- Virginia Repertory Theatre presents **ON AIR**, directed by Artistic Director of Education, Todd D. Norris, at Hanover Tavern Mar 15 - Apr 14, 2024. The musical is about two unsung radio pioneers who broke through the static and established the first radio station in America.

Amidst the turbulent 1920's, Frank and Flora Conrad were on the edge of discovering mass broadcasting. They established the first radio station in America within their own unassuming garage in East Pittsburgh. **ON AIR** follows their untold love story, their professional victories and disappointments, as well as their journey in establishing broadcast radio as a constant companion, messenger, and soundtrack for the life of every American.
