The musical is based on the original story by Hans Christian Andersen, and was adapted by Richard Giersch with music by Jason Marks, who is also the musical director. Jan Guarino will direct.

The musical is most appreciated by children ages 4-10, and will be presented in the Jessie Bogese Theatre at Virginia Rep Center for Arts and Education.
