Virginia Repertory Theatre Announces Two Additional Titles for 2017/18 Season

River Ditty, a World Premiere in collaboration with Tony Award-winning Glass Half Full Productions

and

Fun Home, Winner of the 2015 Tony Award for Best Musical Co-produced by Virginia Rep and Cadence Theatre Company in Celebration of Richmond Triangle Players' 25th Anniversary Season

Richmond, VA – Virginia Repertory Theatre made public additional titles for the 2017/18 Season today. "Announcing *River Ditty* and *Fun Home* simultaneously illuminates Virginia Rep's commitment to bold new work," says Artistic Director, Nathaniel Shaw.

On the Signature Season, the World Premiere of *River Ditty* by Matthew Keuter will run from April 18 through May 6, 2018, on the Arenstein Stage in the November Theatre. Shaw has worked for over 5 years with Keuter on the script, including a two-week workshop at Virginia Rep last December. "As Director, I have led development on this

passionate and timely play since 2012, and I am overjoyed to finally see it burst into full bloom."

Virginia Rep is delighted to collaborate with Tony and Olivier Award-winning Glass Half Full Productions, best recognized for the Tony Award-winning production of *Curious Incident of the Dog in the Nighttime, Twelfth Night,* and *Richard III* starring Mark Rylance, and the Olivier Award-winning *Sunny Afternoon*. The producer recently spoke of their involvement with *River Ditty.* "Part of our mission at Glass Half Full Productions is to develop thought-provoking and timely new work. We are proud to champion Matthew and Nathaniel and our long association with this pertinent and universal play."

River Ditty sweeps us from New Orleans' Storyville district, up the mighty Mississippi, into the woods of Arkansas. Pursued by their dangerous past, Arlo and Sunshine set off on a journey of self-determination, finding love in the most unexpected of places. This American adventure skillfully weaves many of today's most pressing social issues into a turn of the twentieth century folk-tale, challenging a new generation to break away from the hatred, violence, and bigotry passed down through family lines.

On the Cadence Season, *Fun Home* will run from September 9 through October 8, 2017, in Virginia Rep's Theatre Gym. Directed by Virginia Rep's Associate Artistic Director, Chase Kniffen, *Fun Home* is a co-production between Virginia Rep and Cadence Theatre Company in recognition of Richmond Triangle Players' 25th Anniversary. Cadence Theatre Artistic Director, Anna Johnson, expressed her excitement about the co-production. "We are thrilled to work with Virginia Rep on this moving and groundbreaking musical and to celebrate RTP and their endless contributions to our community. We are proud to be one of the first regional theatres to stage the production and can't wait for Richmond audiences to experience it."

With book and lyrics by Lisa Kron and music by Jeanine Tesori, *Fun Home* won five Tony Awards including Best Musical. Based on Alison Bechdel's best-selling graphic novel, the play moves from past to present as Alison sketches out her childhood memories in both poignant and comic tone.

Years after her father's unexpected death, Alison comes to terms with memories of her unique childhood, growing up in the Bechdel Funeral Home, while reliving her struggles

to connect with her father and her growing awareness of her own homosexuality. This groundbreaking musical is funny, honest and painfully uplifting.
