Dear Jack, Dear Louise

Richmond, VA -- Virginia Repertory Theatre brings a new Ken Ludwig play to Hanover Tavern March 18 – April 17. *Dear Jack, Dear Louise* tells the joyous, heartwarming story of Ludwig's own parents' courtship during World War II. When two strangers meet by letter during the war, a love story begins. U.S. Army Captain Jack Ludwig, a military doctor stationed in Oregon, begins writing to Louise Rabiner, an aspiring actress and dancer in New York City, hoping to meet her someday if the war will allow. But as the war continues, it threatens to end their relationship before it even starts.

Two-time Olivier Award-winning playwright Ludwig has landed six shows on Broadway and seven in London's West End. Virginia Rep previously produced Ludwig's **Lend Me a Tenor** (2011) and **The Game's Afoot or Holmes for the Holidays** (2019).

Neal Gallini-Burdick (Jack Ludwig) is excited to make his Hanover Tavern debut. He recently performed on tour with Virginia Rep in several shows including *I Have a Dream, Buffalo Soldier, Hansel and Gretel*, and *A Christmas Carol*. He is a recent graduate of the University of Mary Washington, where he received a B.A. in Theatre. Favorite credits include Macbeth in *Macbeth*, Martin in *The Goat, or Who Is Sylvia*, and Clive Paget/John Jasper in *The Mystery of Edwin Drood*.

Lydia Hundley (Louise Rabiner), graduated from the University of Mary Washington with a B.A. in Theater, and serves as the Director of Education and Outreach at Swift Creek Mill Theater. Favorite credits include Medium Alison in *Fun Home*, Beth in *Merrily We Roll Along*, Juror 8 in *12 Angry Women*, and Edwin Drood in *The Mystery of Edwin Drood.*

Debra Clinton (Director) returns to directing for Virginia Rep at the Hanover Tavern with this production of *Dear Jack, Dear Louise*. Recent credits include *The Sound of Music* at the Weinstein JCC, and a stage appearance as Janine in *The Niceties* for The Conciliation Lab. Deb's work has been seen at the Tavern with such shows as *The Game's Afoot: Holmes for the Holidays* and *Miracle on South Division Street*, and 1776 and *The Whipping Man* on the November Theatre stage. Debra is fortunate to be a long time member of the Richmond, Virginia theatre community and has had the opportunity to contribute artistically to many local theatres. This year marks her 15th anniversary as Artistic Director of the Jewish Family Theatre at the Weinstein JCC, and her sixth year as a teacher in Hanover County.
